Friends of America Rally Reaches Maximum Capacity Up to 100,000 May Attend Largest Labor Day Gathering in America

Organizers Close Distribution of Free Tickets

September 1, 2009 – Overwhelming demand to attend America’s largest Labor Day gathering has prompted organizers to announce that maximum capacity has been reached and tickets to the event are no longer available. Organizers expect that a total of 100,000 people may attend the September 7th rally being held on a previous surface mine near Holden, West Virginia.

With the large number of participants, traffic is anticipated to be very heavy and guests are strongly encouraged to come early. Parking areas will open at 6:00 a.m. and participants are encouraged to come between 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. for the best parking areas. To help with traffic, several offsite parking areas are being designated and bus shuttle service will be provided. Due to the number of vehicles, carpooling is strongly encouraged.

“We are pleased so many people want to come out and celebrate the American worker on Labor Day,” said Don Blankenship, chairman and CEO of Massey Energy. “Unfortunately the site for the rally can only handle so many people. With this much enthusiasm, this many attendants and volunteers and all of these great entertainers and speakers, we are certain to have a good time, but we only have so much room.”

The rally, which invites hard working people from across the country to celebrate the American worker, has attracted this enormous crowd with its message of standing up for American jobs and a great line up of musical entertainers and speakers. Headlining the event is nationally syndicated radio host and Fox television personality, Sean Hannity as well as Lord Christopher Monckton, a former science adviser to British Prime Minister Margaret Thatcher. Musical performances will include country music legend Hank Williams Jr. and John Rich. American icon Ted Nugent will serve as the event’s emcee.

“Friends of America Rally” will be held on Monday, September 7, 2009, from 9:30 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. To provide entertainment to the diverse crowd of all ages, a karaoke competition has been added for Saturday, September 5 from 3:00 p.m. till 7:00 p.m. for the area’s youth.
